The Infectious Disease Monitoring/Prediction Center will become an International Center where to identify specific biomarkers (including immunological as well as genomic marker) along with critical determinants (i.e. socio-economic, lifestyle, etc) to identify groups at high risk of morbidities (infection persistence and progression).
